Our school water coolers are provided by <u>AquAid</u> who have given us the opportunity to help those less fortunate than ourselves. With each purchase of a water cooler, an automatic donation is made to the Africa Trust. These funds are used to build 'Elephant Pumps' - a modified version of an age-old Chinese rope pulley system.

We were delighted to see that one such pump has been installed in Manicaland, a province in northeast Zimbabwe, on our school's behalf, with a nice message highlighting our donation. It will be a much-needed source of clean and fresh drinking water for the whole community.
